For 30 years, Extraordinary Families has been joining children in foster care with stable, nurturing families and supporting vulnerable youth transition out of the system and into adulthood. Our person-centered model reduces childhood trauma, encourages safety and stability, and empowers children and youth to heal and thrive.

In 2018 and 2022, Extraordinary Families earned the prestigious three-year accreditation by CARF International, a non-profit, independent accreditor of health and human services. CARF monitors and guides agencies worldwide to ensure top-quality services are delivered following best practices in the industry.

Additionally, since 2009, we have been a recognized leader in supporting and serving LGBTQ+ families and youth by the All Children, All Families program, and we were among the first and continue to be recognized as an innovator in supporting and serving the LGBTQ+ community – which is the highest tier of recognition.

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Foster Care

Foster care offers temporary havens for children unable to stay with their families due to abuse or neglect. Resource (foster) families offer safe, nurturing homes for these children, supporting their healing and growth while their parents work on addressing the challenges that brought their children into care. Reunification is the goal, focusing on preserving family bonds and prioritizing the child's welfare.

When the social worker arrived at their home with a six-month-old baby boy, Simon and Benito felt a mix of excitement and nerves when they first held him in their arms. Having never parented before, they were stunned by the sudden responsibility. But their natural instincts soon kicked in, they recalled all their training and preparation, and they quickly dove into parenthood.

Joining ExtraFam as resource parents in 2022, Simon and Benito were driven by a deep desire to create a forever family through adoption while helping children in need along the way. They embodied child-centered care, dedicating themselves completely. After seven months, the first baby they cared for was reunited with his family. In that time, they realized how deeply this experience could expand their hearts. They maintain a relationship with him and his family, remaining a part of his life and extended network of loving adults.

Simon and Benito have since cared for and supported the reunification of five children with their families. "It's really hard, at first," Benito shares, "but it turns into happy memories and more children to love."

Presently, Simon and Benito are nurturing a five-month-old baby. Every simple interaction with her fills their hearts with pride. Offering advice to those embarking on a similar journey, they reassure, "even though it can be tough, you've got this, and you can do it! Don't give up, because there's no greater joy."

Christina & Adrian together again

"Christina's" anticipation of raising her son, "Adrian" turned to devastation when her child was taken into foster care instead of returning home with her after his birth at the hospital. Feeling bewildered and overwhelmed, Christina spent every moment allowed with Adrian during monitored family time at ExtraFam. She clung to every fleeting moment with him, treasuring the daily photos shared by his resource parent.

As the days turned into weeks, and weeks into months, Christina's determination only grew stronger. She threw herself into growing as a parent and improving her circumstances, attending parenting classes, therapy sessions, and court hearings with relentless dedication. Along the way, she formed deep connections with other parents going through similar struggles, finding solace and solidarity in their shared experiences.

Nearly sixteen months later, after meeting all requirements and demonstrating her stability and commitment, Christina was finally able to bring Adrian home. Adrian's resource parent, who supported her every step of the way, had become a mentor, and continues to play a significant role in their lives, lovingly known as "forever Auntie R."

Christina's journey is a poignant reminder that, especially in the hardest of times, a caring, compassionate community makes all the difference. It underscores the importance of those willing to dive in and provide support in times of deep struggle. For Christina and Adrian, their journey back to each other was not easy, but it was worth every obstacle overcome and made possible by Christina's profound strength and perseverance and a caring resource parent who was willing to be there every step of the way. Jamie and Mary had always dreamed of starting a family together. However, after successfully helping two children reunite with their families, the grief they experienced after saying goodbye left them feeling uncertain about their readiness to parent again. They found comfort within their community of fellow ExtraFam resource families. Offering advice and lending a listening ear, the group provided invaluable support, helping them with the challenges of the unknown on their fostering journey. "You have to be willing to ride the waves," Jamie recalls, "you might have a plan, but there may be surprises." With the group's guidance and encouragement, the couple were reminded of their role: to provide a child with a loving home for however long that child needs.

When the call came about Dylan, their hearts swelled with a mixture of excitement and apprehension. Overcoming their nerves and bolstered by their commitment to provide love and stability for children, they welcomed Dylan into their home.

Throughout Dylan's time in their care, the couple prioritized maintaining her ties with her family of origin. Recognizing the significance of these bonds, they enriched Dylan's life with a sense of belonging, community, and family.

Their journey towards adopting Dylan underlines the profound impact of love and the significance of honoring a child's heritage. By supporting Dylan's connections with her family of origin, they not only provided a loving home but also nurtured her sense of identity and belonging.





Carrie & Bobby it takes a village

Carrie and Bobby's journey to parenthood began with a simple desire to make a difference. When they first learned about fostering through ExtraFam, they felt like it was meant to be. They attended orientation and training and felt drawn towards the warmth and encouragement they received. "Every step of the way, we were more encouraged."

Their journey had its ups and downs. They experienced the bittersweetness of children leaving their care but remained resolute. When they got the call about Hairo, they knew it was their moment. From then on, he was family, no questions asked.

Despite Hairo's health challenges, they never once considered backing down from being his parents. "When the doctors asked if we were still going to do it, it was like, 'Wait, this is not a question. This is our child," Carrie recalls.

They were committed, but also recognized the importance of a strong support system. Amidst the uncertainties, they leaned on each other, their families, and a network of friends for encouragement and guidance. However, it was Hairo's caregiver, Dora, who became their saving grace. "We just felt like a little angel person fell into our laps," Carrie reflects. As Hairo's health improved, they celebrated each triumph, their bond deepening with each shared victory. Carrie's mother also played an indispensable role in Hairo's upbringing, offering her sage advice and boundless love. Together, with their village, they embraced their roles as Hairo's parents wholeheartedly, cherishing every moment of their journey.

Carrie and Bobby's dedication didn't stop at Hairo's adoption. They saw firsthand the impact of foster care and felt compelled to give back. "We were drawn to it," Bobby reflects, "there's so much need in LA." Motivated by the collective efforts of their fostering community, they became ExtraFam ambassadors, advocating tirelessly for the foster care system. Their journey isn't solely about Hairo; it's about forging a better future for all children in need. You'll be surprised at how much you will love, learn, and grow from opening your home and heart in this way.

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Family Resource Center

Thanks to a legacy grant from the John Gogian Family Foundation, our new Family Resource Center (FRC) will provide a range of prevention and early intervention services to help families build resilience, provide a stable and nurturing environment, and address root causes to prevent child abuse and neglect. The FRC, which represents a network of services and resources, will support at-risk and systems-involved families with children of all ages.

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Nurturing Parenting Program

This trauma-informed, family-centered curriculum increases parenting skills, secures attachments, and prevents child abuse and neglect.



Guided Family Time

The greatest predictor of successful reunification is ensuring supportive, quality family time between a parent and their child.

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Case Management

The Center will help families navigate and access needed services that help fulfill legal requirements for reunification.

Through a comprehensive array of services, including education and employment assistance, coordinated access to essential resources, and personalized mentoring, we strive to equip them for success.

At UP4Youth, we recognize that a successful transition into independence hinges on more than just tangible skills; it requires a nurturing support system and a sense of belonging. That's why we foster a community of care, where participants can find encouragement, understanding, and companionship as they embark on their journeys toward self-sufficiency.

We believe in the boundless potential of every young person, regardless of their past. By offering unwavering support and guidance, we aim to empower them to realize their dreams and forge fulfilling futures.

Unstoppable Youth breaking the cycle

At the age of 6, Michelle told her attorney she didn't want to be reunified with her mother. She recounts this day vividly, expressing that in that moment, all she could think about was that one day she'd have children of her own. She didn't want to continue the cycle of familial trauma, abuse, and addiction. She wanted more for her future children. Michelle was determined to break free from all she'd known and forge a new path, taking with her an example of what she did not want to be from her tumultuous upbringing. She was ready to thrive.

Michelle is the first person in her family to graduate high school, the first to obtain a college degree, the first to end a vicious cycle of drug use and addiction, and, she proudly proclaims, "the first person in my family to end generations of awful parenting... my dreams of being the mother I've always wanted has been fulfilled."

Now a mother of three, she often feels exhausted and overwhelmed. The demands of developmental services and extracurricular activities for her children have made it challenging for Michelle to advance her career and education. With the support of the UP4Youth internship program, she has found an opportunity that offers the freedom and flexibility to balance her roles as a mom and a budding professional. She plans to enroll in a four-year university in the fall of 2024. "Extraordinary Families has helped me obtain a job that I love and has given me amazing mentors, while also allowing me to bring hope to many others who have faced similar life-changing circumstances. [I am] the first person in my family to choose what is right. I broke the cycle."

Advocacy

We champion the rights and needs of children and youth in the child welfare system through awareness, policy change, support for families, and ensuring that children in care receive proper services and resources. Through these efforts, we strive to create a more affirming and nurturing environment for these children and youth, ultimately working towards positive outcomes for all vulnerable youth.



Helped secure \$8.8 million for one-time bridge funding for Foster Family Agencies. Advocated for and helped secure \$4 million to increase capacity for expedited background checks.



Advocated for legislation aimed to provide extra educational support for disadvantaged students to improve their academic outcomes.



Engaged our constituents to support measures to provide mental health first aid training for school personnel to better address the psychological distress among California youth.



Signed letter of support urging California's congress to pass legislation to continue Medicaid coverage for kids in foster care.



Advocated and helped ensure the removal of discriminatory barriers to mental health services for youth covered by Medi-Cal.



Engaged in advocacy efforts for legislative protection of LGBTQ+ youth in foster care, creating safer and more inclusive environments for them and ensuring their access to affirming and supportive care.



Welcomed & Affirmed

In light of the escalating assault on LGBTQ+ rights across state legislatures, our commitment to advocacy and support of LGBTQ+ youth and families has never been more steadfast. Through our continued active engagement with initiatives like the Human Rights Campaign's All Children - All Families program, we uphold the highest standards as Innovators, ensuring that inclusivity remains at the forefront of our work.

The surge in anti-LGBTQ+ bills, which has seen a troubling threefold increase between 2022 and 2023, demands attention. With over 500 bills targeting the fundamental rights of LGBTQ+ individuals and communities, spanning realms from education to healthcare and public accommodations, to even the expression of identity through drag performances, the landscape is fraught with challenges. The passage of 84 restrictive bills outside of California underscores the urgency of our collective response.

In Solidarity with the LGBTQ+ community, we adamantly reject these assaults, recognizing them as egregious attempts to silence and erase marginalized voices. The propagation of misinformation, rooted in discrimination and animosity, has manufactured false narratives, perpetuating perceived "threats" that serve only to deepen the marginalization of transgender and non-binary individuals. This not only harms them directly but also undermines the fabric of our society.

Central to our advocacy efforts is a focused dedication to LGBTQ+ youth, who face significant barriers to equal access in educational settings and vital, genderaffirming healthcare. The denial of these basic rights not only impedes their personal development but also poses a threat to the cohesive and inclusive future we strive to build. We are unwaveringly committed to a world where everyone is embraced and celebrated for who they are.


